DESIGN RULES (HB pp 28-29; 79-81)

- 1. You must register for Design Entries prior to the show with the Design Entries Chair.
- 2. An exhibitor may enter multiple classes within the Design Division, but only one (1) exhibit per class.
- 3. Some plant material must be used in every exhibit, fresh and/or dried according to the Schedule. No artificial flowers, foliage, fruits or vegetables, nor are manufactured items simulating plant material will be allowed. Living members of the animal kingdom and taxidermal representations are not permitted, but manufactured or crafted items or toys simulating such are allowed.
- 4. Plant material need not be grown by exhibitor.
- 5. Design must be approved for conformance and classification by the Design Classification Chair, before the exhibitor leaves the show area. Exhibitors are expected to maintain their exhibits in good condition for the duration of the show.
- 6. Only dried material may be painted or treated. Accessories and featured objects may be used throughout.
- 7. Prepared food, cut fruits and/or vegetables are not allowed.
- 8. All plant material used in the design MUST be identified on a 3"x 5" card, provided by the exhibitor and included with the entry card. In addition to stating the plant materials used, a design interpretation may also be included on a 3" x 5" card.
- 9. The exhibit must be the work of only one (1) exhibitor and that exhibitor's name must appear on the entry card.
- 10. Designer is on her/his honor that the design being entered has not been previously entered or judged in an NGC Flower Show.
- 11. The Scale of Points for Design is listed in the Handbook for Flower Shows, pp 130.
