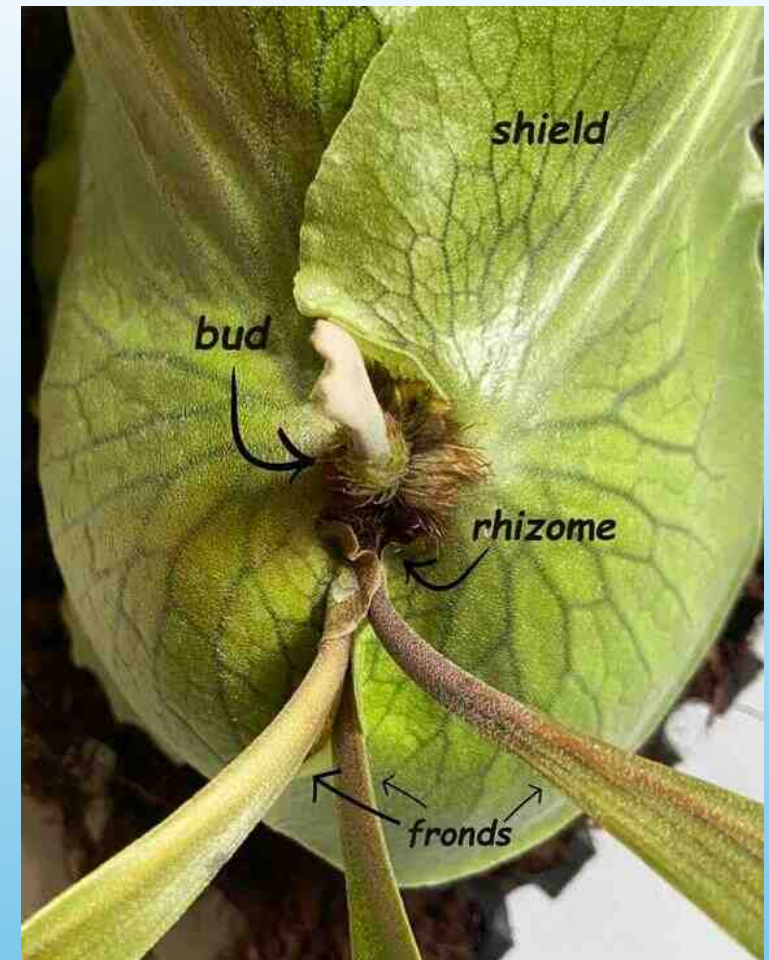

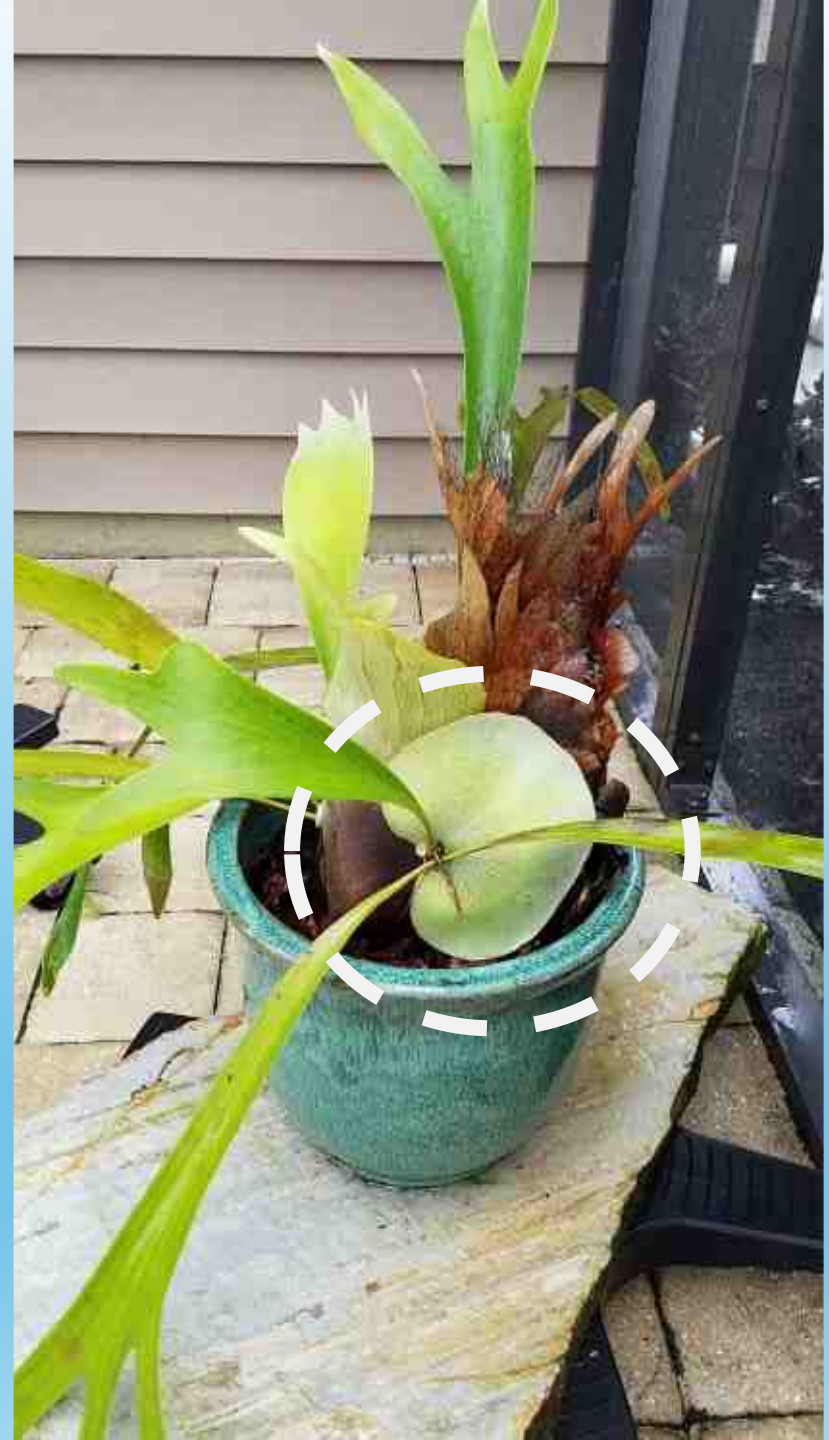

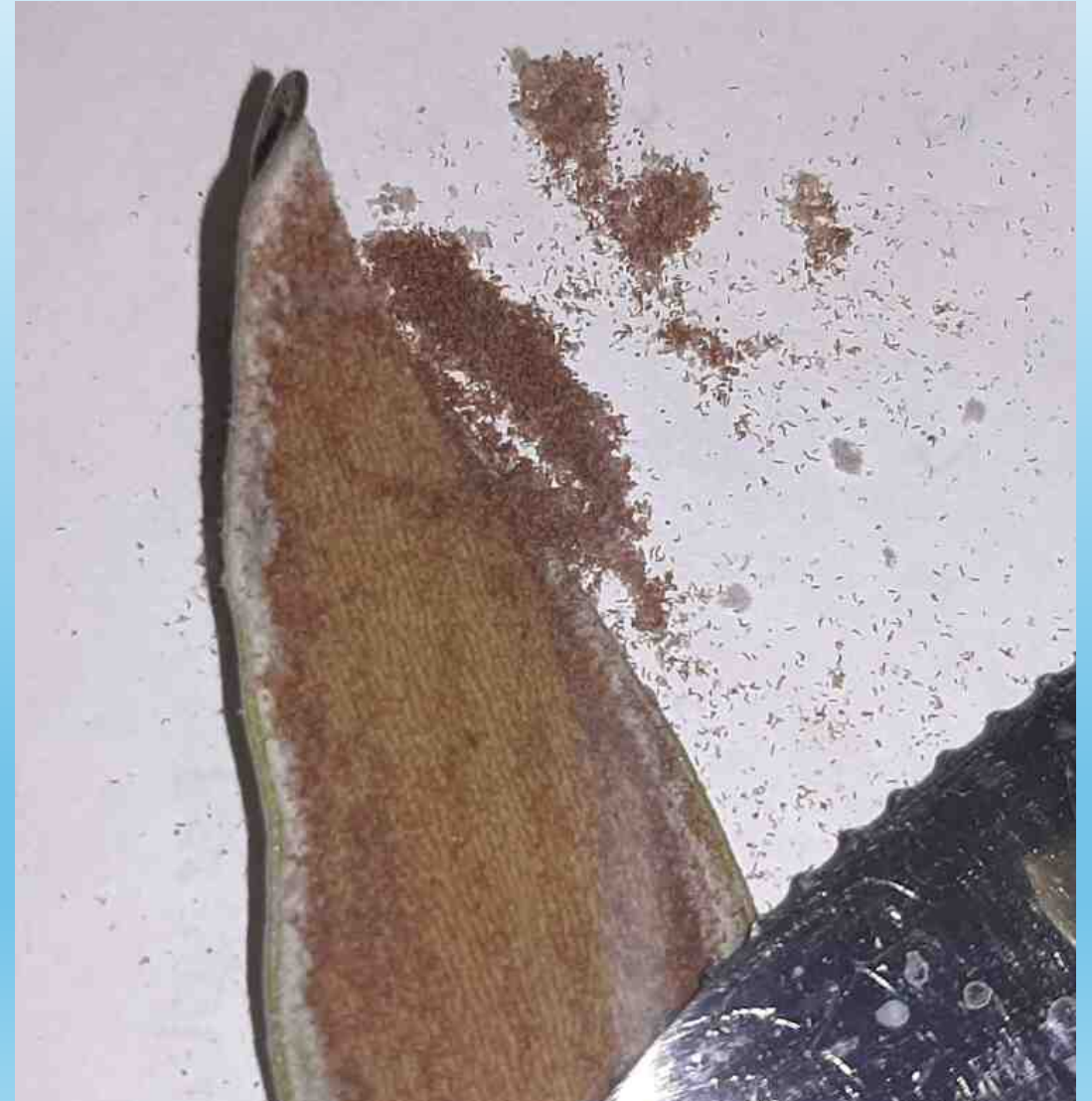

Propagation by Spores



The brown patch is called: sporangia



- Spores need moist, indirect light
- Germinate into gametophyte (tiny, heart shaped structures)

Gametophyte produces sperm and egg cells, which fuse to form a new fern.

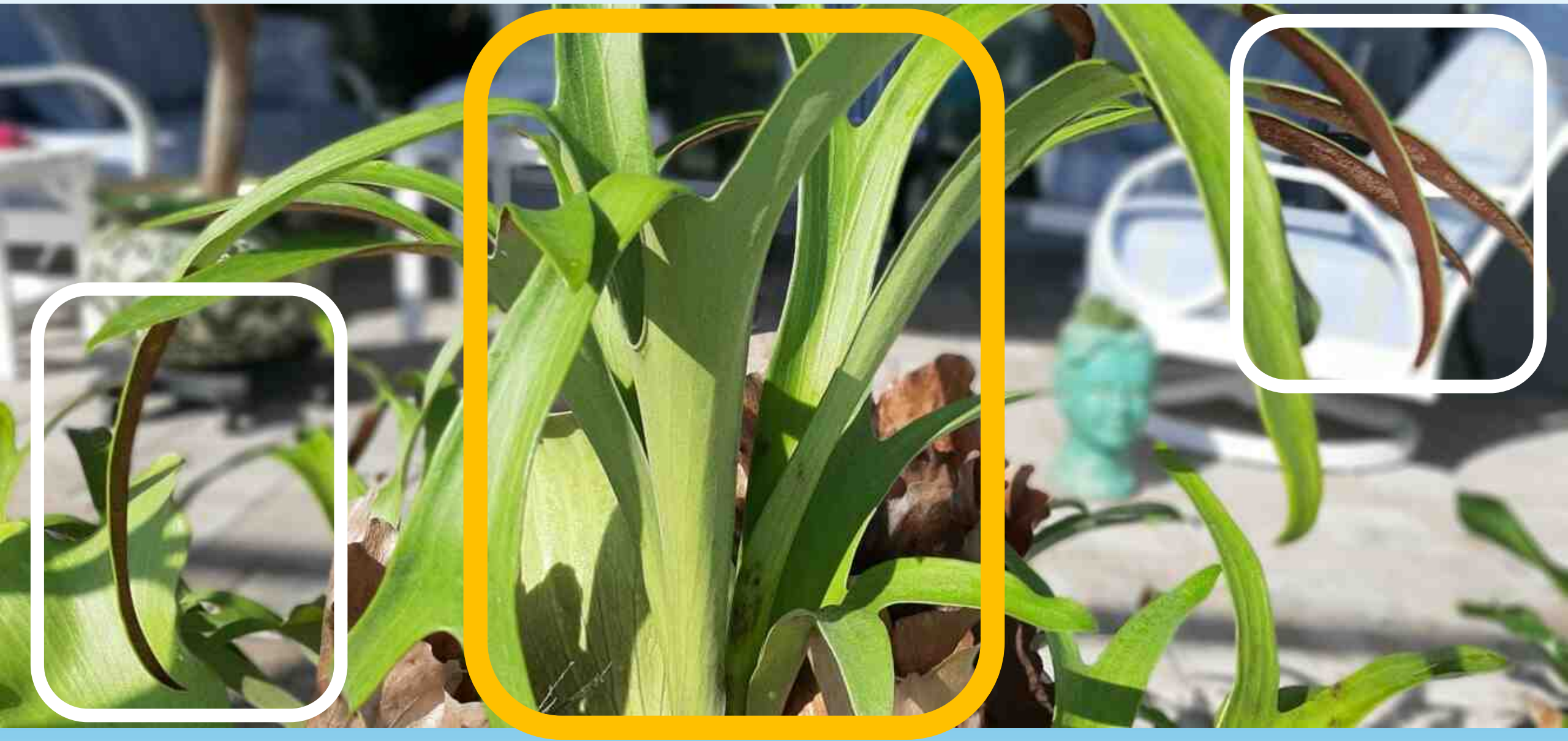
