

# The Elements & Principles of Design

## *Elements "The Tools"*

**Light:** the illumination necessary for vision and visual response

**Line:** a one-dimensional visual path through the design

**Form:** a three-dimensional object or contour

**Color:** how the eye responds to and interprets light rays

**Pattern:** the arrangement of solids and spaces within the silhouette

**Texture:** the surface quality of a material

**Size:** Visual or perceived dimension of a line, form, shape or space

**Space:** the open area in and around a design

## *Principles "The Rules"*

**Balance:** visual stability

**Dominance:** one or more stronger Elements have greater impact,  
implying subordination

**Contrast:** using unlike or opposite Elements to emphasize their differences

**Rhythm:** dominant visual path of line(s), form(s), and/or color(s)  
throughout the design

**Proportion:** the comparative relationship of areas and amounts

**Scale:** the size relationship of one object to another
